Amendments to the CCS Constitution & Bylaws

The amendments proposed at the May 2007 meeting were approved by the Cave Survey and have been ratified by 2/3 of the Colorado grottos. They are now in effect as part of the Colorado Cave Survey Constitution Bylaws. In brief, these amendments add the following to the Constitution and Bylaws (copies of the complete text will be available at the meeting):

1. Administrative – instructs the CCS chair to keep survey records up to date with the NSS.
2. Creates of the position of a CCS Vice-Chair.
3. Confidentiality of the CCS Files. Requires a two-thirds vote of the CCS membership to allow any person access to the CCS files, and requires person requesting access to sign a confidentiality agreement which restricts the dissemination of the information in the files.
